Flamingos, which are pink in color, get the pink shade from their diet which includes shrimp and blue-green algae. Carotenoids are broken down in the liver, after which the molecular form of these is sent to the skin, legs, beaks, and feathers of flamingos, which gives them a beautiful pink shade.
